
Ugo Marani, edited by, The Economics Of The Unified Germany: An Interested Lok From Southern Italy

Germany's reunification is an extraordinarily rel-evant event for having contributed to a new par-adigm of regional development policies in Europe. For Italy the interest is still greater. The book, containing various essays, focuses on the economie policies for the Eastern Lànder to assess, first, whether the Germany pro-posals may be easily replicated, and secondly, whether the lack of economie convergence of Italy's southern regions could be avoided.
